Recycle

On our Wednesday garbage collection day Solid Waste Management also picks-up items to recycle which are placed five feet from the garbage bin. Recycle: newspapers, magazines, shopping catalogs, junk mail, home office paper; tin, steel and aluminum; #1 and #2 plastic bottles or jugs and corrugated cardboard flattened and bundled. Put items in city recycle bags or any sturdy clear plastic bags or the 9 gallon waste bin. Do not recycle styrofoam, chipboard (cereal boxes). Glass containers can be taken to Solid Waste Management on 4600 Edith NE or other bins around the City.
