#### Traffic study along Indian School Road Results:

Diane Dolan, Policy Analyst for City Councilor Isaac Benton reported that a traffic study on Indian School conducted by the Albuquerque Department of Municipal Development was completed: the traffic volumes were low, the average speeds were reasonable and 85% of the speeds were as expected for this type of area. Traffic Engineering also looked at accident statistics and concluded there was no remarkable pattern or volume. Posted speed limits are 40 mph with several segments of Indian School Rd (by Montezuma School) posted at 35 mph. The Board will follow up with Councilor Benton's office. #### Undercrossings for bike path

Council Benton's Office reported that three undercrossings will be built in the next few years at Candelaria, Comanche and Menaul. These undercrossings are at 95% design and expected implementation will begin in the next year. These locations were determined as a higher need over an undercrossing at Indian School Road because of the greater volume of traffic on those roadways and the poor line of site at those locations.

Remember 25 mph speed limits are posted for all streets in the neighborhood and STOP at posted stop signs...lives may depend on it.
